## Planning Commission Public Hearing on LID Scheduled for October 5

At its next meeting the Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to discuss proposed changes to development regulations that will require use of Low Impact Development (LID) techniques, where feasible, for managing stormwater in new development.

The public hearing will be 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 5 at the Snohomish School District Resource Center, 1601 Avenue D. The public is encouraged to attend and participate.

The proposed changes are required by the City's NPDES (National Pollution Discharge Elimination System) Phase II stormwater permit. The permit is issued by the Washington State Department of Ecology (DOE). Included in the proposal is adoption of DOE's 2012 Stormwater Manual for Western Washington.


