City Council to Discuss Construction Noise

The City Council will discuss whether regulations for construction noise should be revised to decrease the hours when construction noise is allowed. The discussion will be during their November 1, 2016 meeting.

Current regulations allow construction noise from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on weekends. The regulation applies to homeowners working on home improvement projects as well as to contractors.

Staff will be seeking direction from the City Council on whether to research and write an ordinance that would place greater restrictions on noise, on weekdays, weekends, and holidays.



Seattle historian, Michael Herschensohn, will give a reprise of his *Humanities Washington* presentation that Warner Blake attended in 2011, which inspired his writing of *J.S.
