

## Planning Department Front Counter Hours

As a reminder, the Planning and Permitting front counter at City Hall is closed to the public on Fridays. However, staff is available by appointment. Monday through Thursday, the staff is available to the public without an appointment from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Closing the counter on Fridays allows the department to operate more efficiently by providing staff opportunities to have uninterrupted time to devote to complex projects.

Planning, permitting, and building staff will continue to perform field work and do site inspections on Fridays and will be fully available to those who make an appointment, which can be scheduled as late as Friday morning.

Other front counter activities (utility payments, business and pet licenses, service requests) at City Hall are unaffected by this change.



**2017 SUMMER YARD WATERING CALENDAR**

From your water provider. Calendar on reverse side.

**WATER CONSERVATION TIPS:**

- Water your lawn every third day if needed. Use this calendar as a guide.
- Group plants according to their water needs; this makes watering more efficient.
- Sweep sidewalks and patios with a broom instead of hosing them off.
- Adjust sprinklers so only your lawn is watered, not the sidewalk or street.
