## *Snohomish Carnegie Foundation Block Party*

The Snohomish Carnegie Foundation is celebrating the completion of the first phase of the Carnegie Library rehabilitation with a Block Party from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup>. The free party will take place at the corner of First Street and Cedar Avenue, and will include children's activities, live music, a tour of the Carnegie Building with Bola Architecture, a silent auction, vendor booths, and a special welcome to the new business neighbors.

The Foundation thanks its event sponsors: Mariposa Day Spa, Snohomish Bakery at First & Union, First & Union Kitchen, Blanc & Rouge, Tammy's Boutique, Top It Yogurt, and Crepe Escape & Coffee House.

This first phase of rehabilitation has created a seismically-sound building, capable of withstanding a major earthquake. The roof and walls have been stabilized, hazardous materials have been removed, insulation has been added, wall-floor connections have been strengthened, and the building's perimeter has been upgraded. The City of Snohomish and the Snohomish Carnegie Foundation secured \$1,047,244 in donations and grants to fund the rehabilitation.

When the entire Carnegie rehabilitation/restoration is complete, the historic Library will become the Carnegie Educational Center: A Place For Families. This Center will offer educational, cultural and recreational programs for children, youth, adults, and families.


