Snoqualmie Ice Cream Hosts its First Annual Easter Egg Hunt with Snohomish Chamber of Commerce

Snoqualmie Ice Cream and the Snohomish Chamber of Commerce proudly present, **Snoqualmie Ice Cream's Annual Easter Egg Hunt!** The hunt will take place at Snoqualmie's mini-farm in Maltby, following the Snohomish Easter Parade and Bonnet Making Contest. The free, all-ages event will be from 3:00 p.m.-5:00 p.m., with the hunt beginning at 3:30 p.m. and divided by age groups. Snoqualmie has over 6,000 eggs to hide, which will be filled with candy and special surprises. All attendees will be invited to participate in a free raffle, which will give away prizes from local partners, including the Parents Union, Haggen, Theo Chocolates, Lunchbox Laboratory, Ivar's Acres of Clams, Top Pot Doughnuts, and DRY Soda!

The **Easter Parade** held on First Street in downtown Snohomish is the only Easter Parade in Washington State. The parade is open to any and all participants. Parade applications are available online at www.cityofsnohomish.com or visit the Snohomish Chamber of Commerce Facebook page for application information. The deadline for submission of parade entries is March 25, 2013.

Keeping with tradition, the Snohomish County Tribune's "Easter Bunny" will be leading the parade and welcoming our crowd to Snohomish. This year's parade sponsors are Gilpin Realty, Stocker Farms, Cascade Fence, Faith Assembly Church, Cross View Church, Catch the Beat, and Snoqualmie Ice Cream.
