9.72.005 Statues Incorporated by Reference. The provisions of the following state statues are incorporated by reference in this chapter:

- RCW 9A.72.140 Jury Tampering
RCW 9A.72.150 Tampering With Physical
Evidence

9.72.010 Criminal contempt. A person shall be guilty of criminal contempt by willfully committing one or more of the following acts:

- A. Disorderly, contemptuous, or insolent behavior committed during the sitting of the Snohomish City Council, in its immediate view and presence and directly tending to interrupt its proceedings; or
- B. Breach of the peace, noise, or other disturbance directly tending to interrupt the proceedings of the Snohomish City Council.

Criminal contempt is a gross misdemeanor.
