City of Snohomish ORDINANCE 1918

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SNOHOMISH, WASHINGTON ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY FOR THE YEAR 1999 AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 1883.

WHEREAS, the Snohomish City Council adopted the 1999 Budget by passing Ordinance 1883 on December 1, 1998; and

WHEREAS, employment contracts for employees were under negotiation with Teamsters Local 763; and

WHEREAS, the contracts of the three bargaining units of Teamsters Local 763, Office/Technical, Police and Public Works, have settled, accepted and approved and salary ranges for all full-time represented employees for the year of 1999 were amended and approved by the Snohomish City Council on June 1, 1999; and

WHEREAS, certain non-represented employees' salaries are set by the City Manager pursuant to SMC 2.64.040, with the concurrence of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the 1999 Budget anticipated that non-represented employees salary adjustments would be determined in relation to represented employees salary adjustments; and

WHEREAS, an amended 1999 salary range for non-represented and/or exempt employees was approved by the Snohomish City Council on June 15, 1999;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF SNOHOMISH, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Certain employees' salaries are set specifically by contractual agreement between the City of Snohomish and Teamsters Union Local No. 763. That salaries for employees included in the bargaining units shall be as specifically set forth in the City of Snohomish Union collective bargaining agreements. That the salaries provided in those agreements now in effect, or which are subsequently amended or replaced during the year 1999 are made a part of this ordinance by this reference.

<u>Section 2</u>. Salaries for non-represented or exempt positions shall be as approved by the City Council on June 15, 1999.

<u>Section 3</u>. The Snohomish City Council hereby amends the 1999 Budget as adopted in Ordinance 1883, to include employee salaries for the year 1999 as follows:
