# CITY OF SNOHOMISH 1ST & AVENUE D TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT MAY 2012

## UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION

The City is pleased to notify the community of the 1<sup>st</sup> & D Traffic Signal project which is expected to begin construction sometime mid to late May of this year. This project is being made possible through a Transportation Improvement Board grant that the City recently received. The grant is funded through state fuel tax which will fund 85% of the project.

The 1<sup>st</sup> & D intersection is a very busy and important intersection for downtown Snohomish. We are excited to have the opportunity to improve this intersection both logistically and aesthetically as it helps to serve as the gateway to our community for now and the future.

The main function of the project will be to install a traffic signal at the intersection to replace the existing 4-way stop. This will vastly improve traffic movement through this intersection which currently maintains capacity issues. Other key components include traffic calming features to improve safety such as adding bulbouts, or protruding curblines at all four corners of the intersection, and a raised crosswalk on across 1<sup>st</sup> Street on the east side of Avenue D.

Additionally, there will be new utilities installed within the intersection which will require some level of temporary lane and road closures.

### ROAD CLOSURES

**Avenue D** Between 1st Street and 2nd Street will have temporary closures starting May 2012.

**1st Street** Between Avenue E and just east of Avenue D will have temporary closures starting May 2012.
