

## ***Applicants Sought for Snohomish Design Review Board***

Applicants are sought for the City of Snohomish Design Review Board to fill a vacancy for the balance of a four-year term expiring October 13, 2013. Sitting board members have the opportunity to request re-appointment at the conclusion of each term.

The applications are due to the City Clerk by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 24, 2012, at City Hall, 116 Union Avenue in Snohomish. The successful candidate will be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council.

The Board primarily considers and reviews rehabilitation and restoration of historic structures and new development in the Historic District to encourage better design and site planning. The City's Historic District represents an economic and cultural asset to the City and design review helps preserve this asset by keeping the historic character intact.

The Board has a current need for a member with training in architecture, architectural history, or historic preservation. Other desired expertise includes history, building trades, landscape architecture, graphic, interior, and industrial design, and land development. Applicants should have an interest in the City as a result of living, working, owning property or business, and/or belonging to one of the City's civic organizations.

The Board typically meets at 7:00 PM on the second Wednesday of each month. Between meetings, board members may be requested to conduct individual-member reviews of smaller projects. All City board and commission members are volunteers serving without compensation.
